North Campus

The tobacco free zone encompasses all Syracuse University property as of July 1, 2015.

This map defines the tobacco-free areas on the Main Campus of Syracuse University. The entire main campus both indoors and outdoors bordered on the north by (but not including) Waverly Avenue and on the south by (but not including) Forestry Drive, extending southeast to Comstock Avenue around the outdoor area surrounding Day, Graham and Flint are part of the smoke and tobacco-free zone. The main campus bordered by (but not including) Irving Avenue on the west and Comstock Avenue to the east is also smoke and tobacco-free both indoors and outdoors.

On the southwest side of campus, Irving Garage, Dineen, Sadler and their surrounding outdoor areas also fall within the tobacco-free zone as well as the area between Oakland Street and Brockway and Boland heading north. Oakland Street, Standart Street, East Raynor Avenue, Henry Street, Van Buren Street, Stadium Place, and Fine View Place are not SU property and therefore are not part of the tobacco-free zone.

On the east side of Syracuse University campus bordered by Comstock Avenue and Ostrom Avenue and Euclid Avenue and East Adams Street, the entire area is tobacco free with the exception of the Greek houses on Comstock Avenue and all streets (exception is University Place which is owned by Syracuse University).

Tobacco-free zones on the northern part of campus include the Chancellor's residence and surrounding property and all SU owned property bordered by Waverly Avenue and Harrison Street including all buildings, parking garages, Marshall Street Mall, and most northern includes Archibold Theater and surrounding outdoor areas as well as the 805 East Genesee Street building and parking area.
